Nomination Packet



This award was established in 2000 in honor of volunteers – “leaders in nursing who exemplify the philosophy that a person can make a difference.”

Purpose

The purpose of this award is to recognize outstanding volunteer effort in support of MOLN by members at either the district or state level.

Intent

Because of the high personal commitment the award represents, it should be understood that the **Star Award** may not be bestowed every year; however, this award is not limited to one individual and several awards may be bestowed in the same year. The award should be given out for recognition of activities undertaken in the last year or in the last several years that have significantly impacted MOLN.

Criteria

To be eligible for nomination, members must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Consistent demonstration of time, energy, enthusiasm, and commitment to MOLN’s mission.
- Development/creation of an innovative idea that furthers the mission of MOLN.
- Outstanding contribution to enhancing the work of the organization/district.

Members must be nominated by another MOLN member.

Nomination Process

On the last sheet of this packet write a paragraph that demonstrates the nominee’s efforts that meet the criteria for nomination.

All Star Award nominations packets must be postmarked by July 1.

Award recipients are selected by members of the professional development committee, which is charged with coordinating the **MOLN Star Award Program** and to forward deserving candidates to the MOLN board for endorsement.

There are many MOLN members who contribute or have contributed significantly over the years to support this organization. Please consider nominating one of your colleagues for this award.
